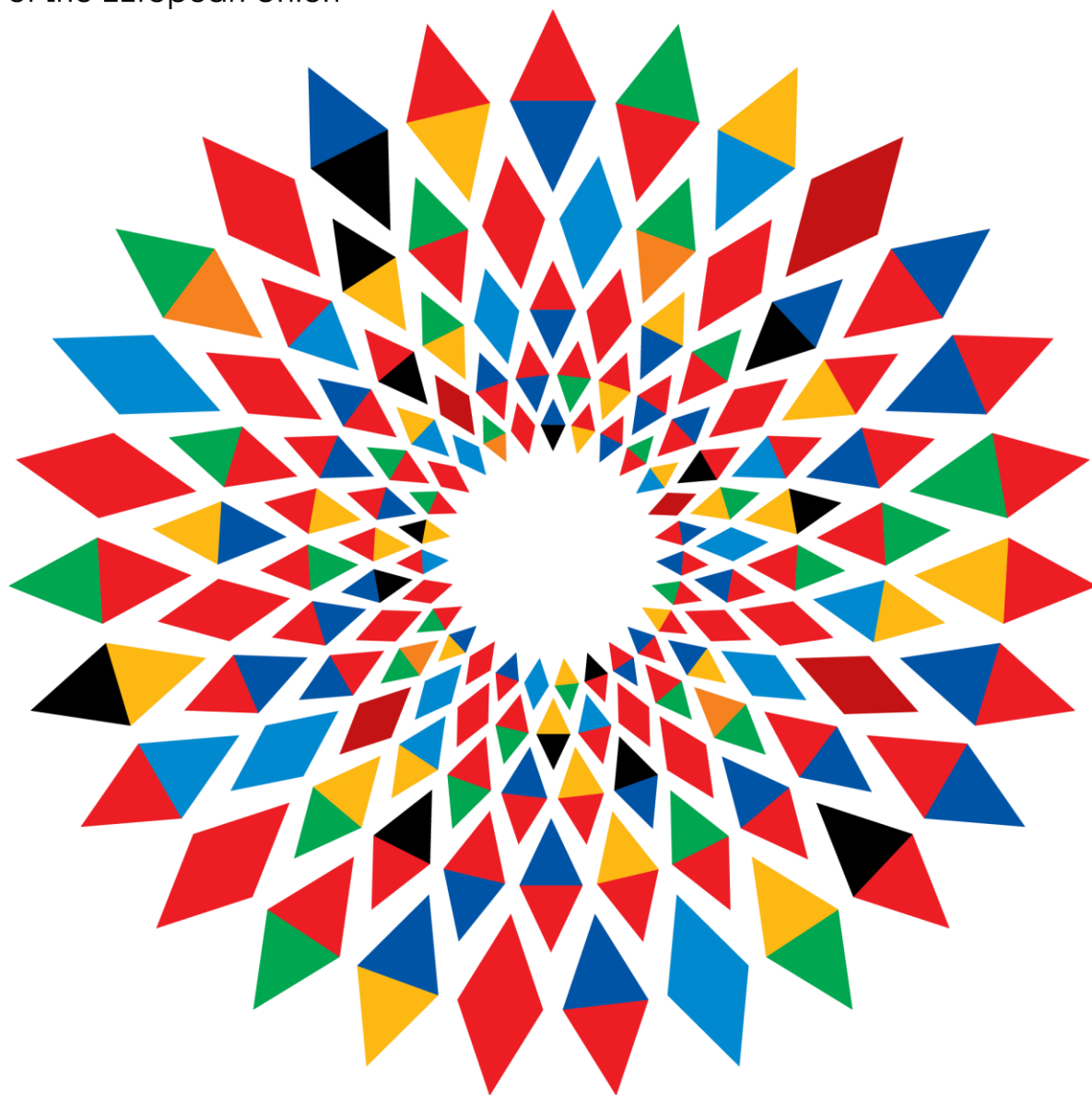

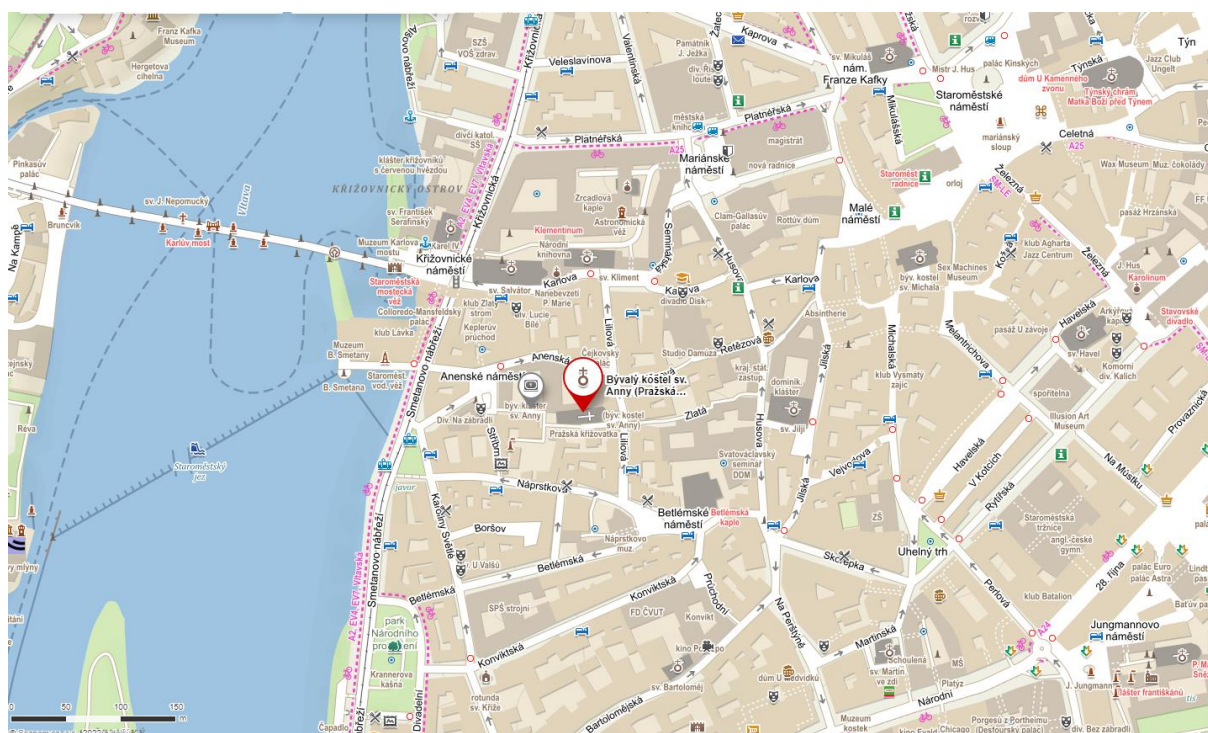

Lunch in a restaurant and a small snack in the bus will be provided. Recommended dress code: leisure.

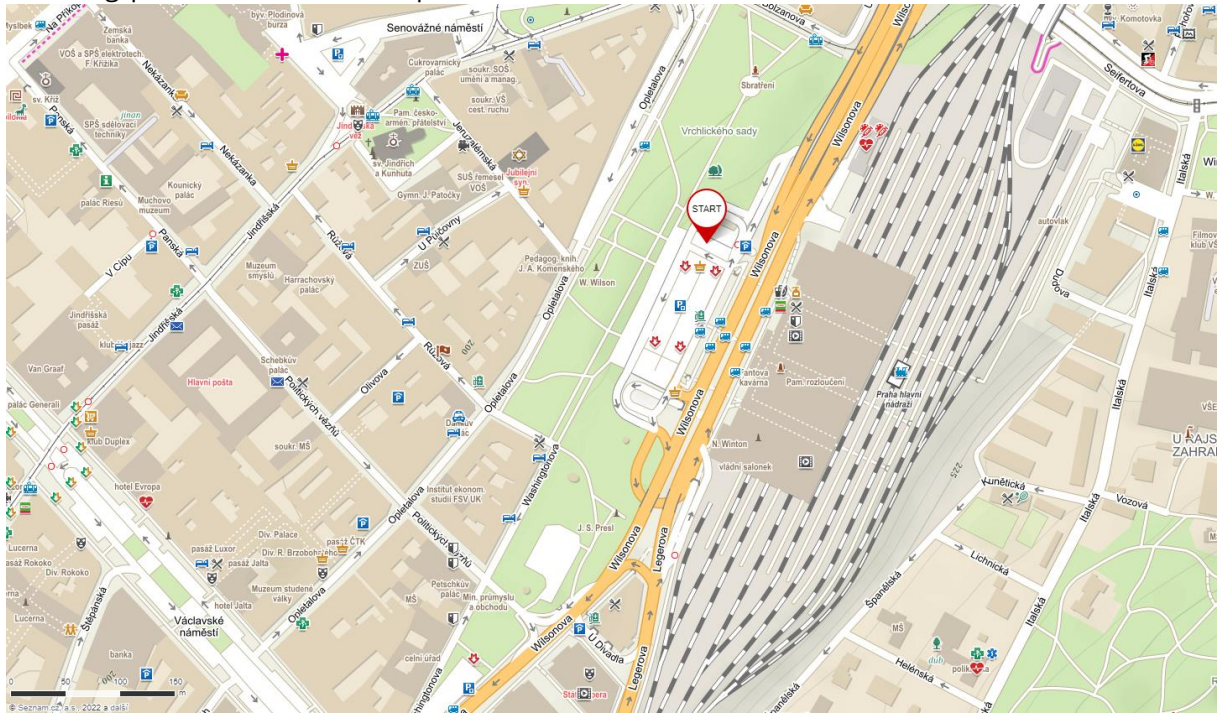

Tour to Prague South City Housing Estate

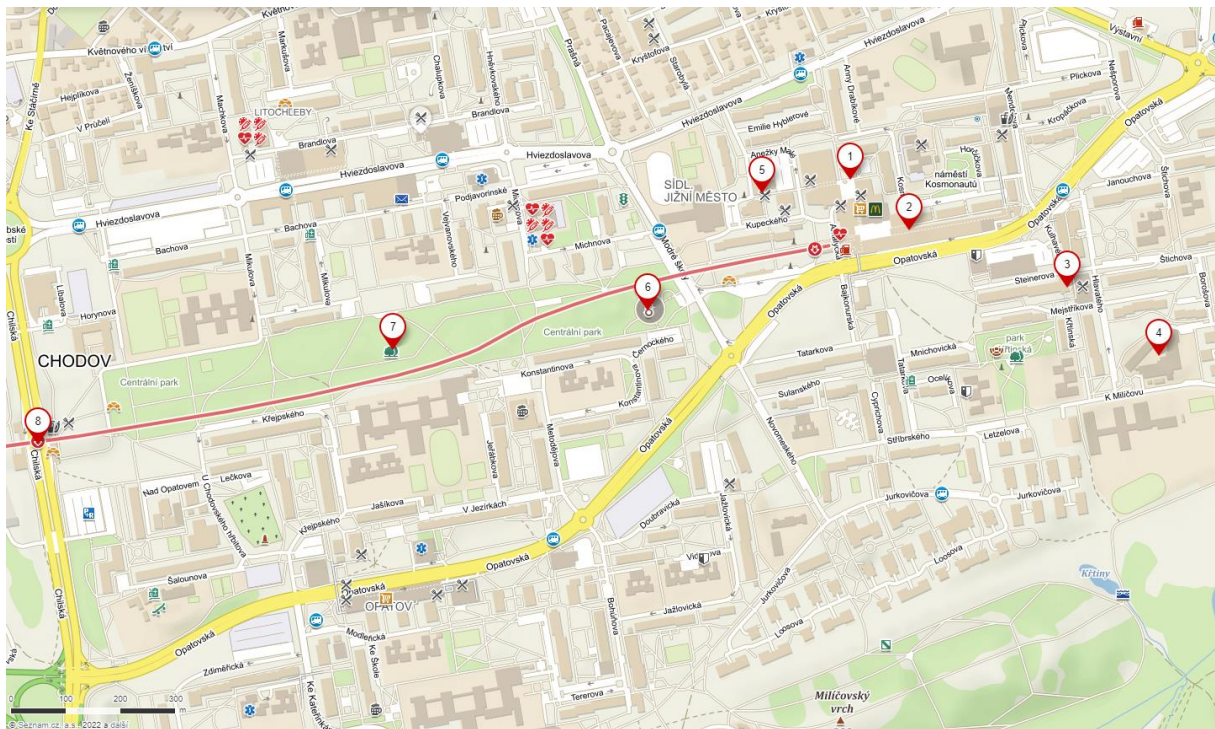
Guided tour in the largest panel-block housing estate from 1970's.
